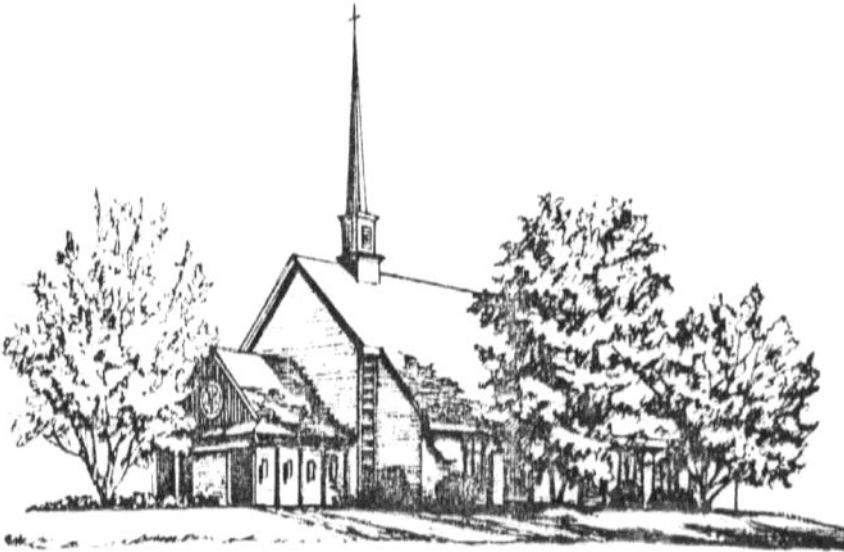

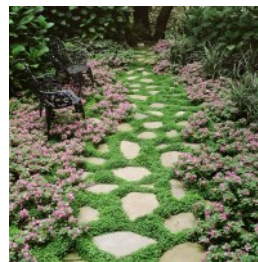
Adult Christian Education meets in the vestry/media room in the education wing after the service.
