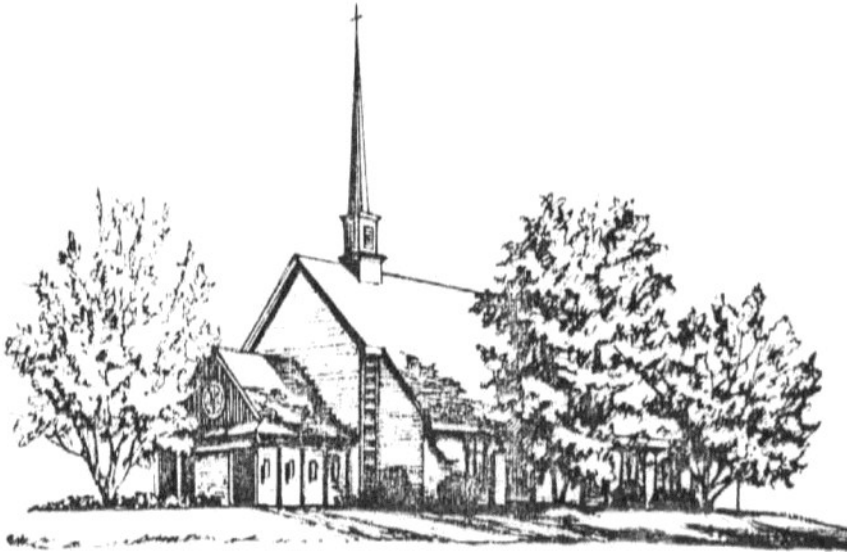

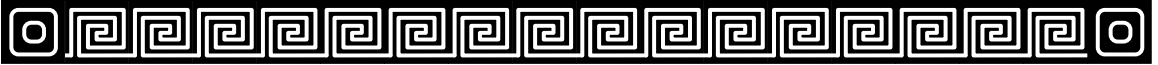
Flower Dedications
