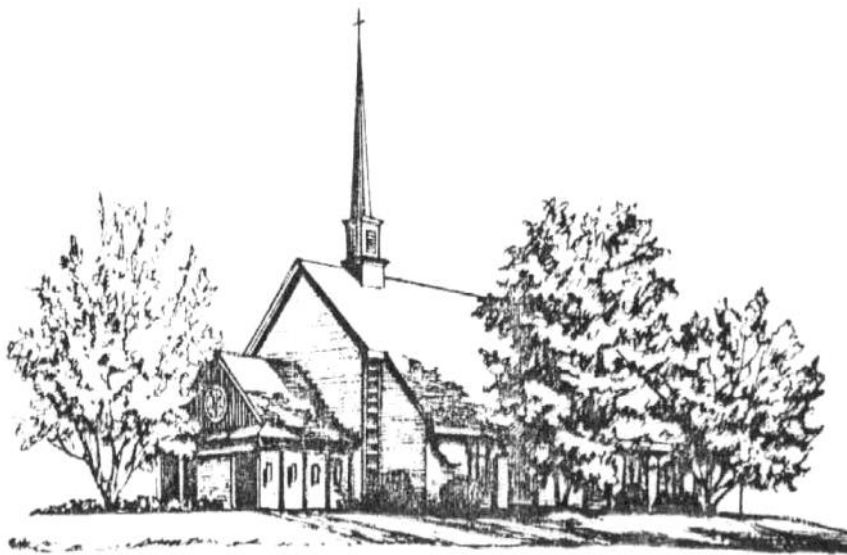

Nursery: Rm. 208. Ages 4 and under. Drop off begins at 9:15am.

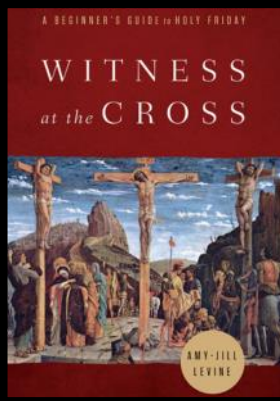
