Adult Christian Ed meets at 10:45am in the vestry meeting room. Join us!

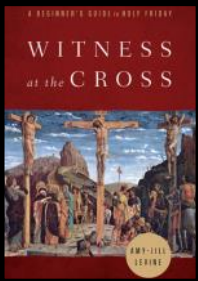
Lenten Soup and Study
