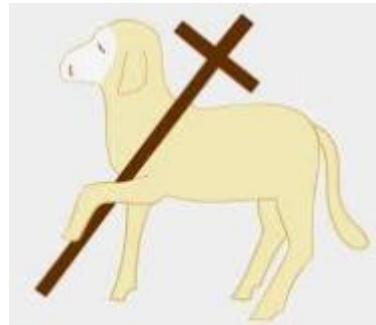
"Lamb of God"
