

9:30am- Decorate the Chrismon Tree

As you come to the altar for communion, please take a Chrismon and place it on the tree. Chrismon means *Christ's Monogram*. Each Chrismon is a meaningful symbol that represents Jesus and our Christian faith. They were handmade by a special group of ladies here at Redeemer many years ago. They consist of beadwork and/or cloth in the colors of white and gold and should be handled with care. Each Chrismon is a treasure and is a beautiful way for us to begin Advent.

10:45am- Intergenerational Advent Activities: Advent Wreaths, Card Making, Ornaments...Oh My! Taper candles and holders will be provided to take home and enjoy this season of Advent. The candles are what mark the weeks and meaning of Advent. They can be arranged in a circle or a row or placed on items at home like a tray or charger. 
