# **Looking Ahead:**

2026 brings Redeemer's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration, the bishop's visitation, and joining with the bishop in new studies. In 2025, we tackled reading the bible; if you're not finished, keep reading – you can do it! If you did finish reading the whole bible, celebrate! If you only started, celebrate! It is not too late to immerse ourselves in scripture; in fact, it's great spiritual practice for every day. See the information at edusc.org/News/The Bishop's Bible-in-a year challenge 2025 for lots of resources to continue with this challenge.

2026 brings a new bishop/diocesan study: *The Bishop Reads*. Below are some details. Let's do this! In his 103rd Convention address, the bishop spoke about four areas in which we will work together this year. One area is **Practice**, and *The Bishop Reads* is part of **Practice**. It is part of our obligation as mature Christians to know Christ. In each quarter, we'll read a book together as a diocese to know Christ better – to keep growing in Christ. In Quarter 1 (Q1), we will read the Gospel of John along with a supplement. You may choose from either of these two titles for the supplement:

- God Dwells with Us: Temple Symbolism in the Fourth Gospel
- John for Everyone


