REDEEMER REMINDERS

****** You don’t want to miss the special music we will have throughout July!

- **7/5—Music of Colonial America:** With this being the 250th anniversary of the founding of our country, we will feature American church music from the 1770s.
- **7/12—Brass Quartet:** Alicia Crutchlow will lead a brass quartet providing music for the prelude, offertory, and postlude....while also joining in on familiar but very festive hymns.
- **7/19—Cool Jazz:** Jacob and Brent will return with some cool jazz for July’s heat.
- **7/26—George Frideric Handel:** Fabulous flautist Kristin Gill will play some of Handel’s concertos for Flute and Harpsichord.

**** Colonial American Church Music Notes:**

Today’s Preludes are “A Lesson” and “Fugue, or Voluntary in D” by William Selby (1738-1798) . Selby emigrated from England in 1770 and was organist King’s Chapel in Boston, as well as Old North Church, where Paul Revere hung his “one if by land, and two if by sea” lanterns.

Today's Anthem is "Let the High Heavens Your Song Invite" by William Billings (1746-1800). Billings was America's first native-born composer and is often considered the father of American choral music.

The postlude "March in D" is by Benjamin Yarnold. After emigrating from England to Charleston, Yarnold was organist/choirmaster at St. Michael's Church in Charleston and was organist for the church service there attended by then President George Washington in 1791. Yarnold is an especially interesting figure because he connects the English organ tradition with the earliest documented concert and church music in colonial Charleston.
